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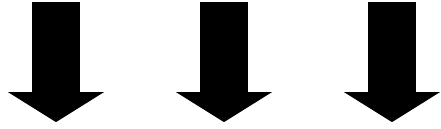
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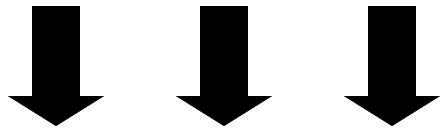

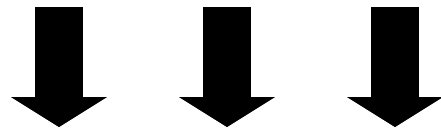

How to Get your Child or Youth into Programs

1. A Referral is required from the Ministry of Children & Family Development—Children & Youth with Special Needs (MCFD-CYSN) Social Worker.
2. To request a referral, you can contact the Chilliwack MCFD Office at: 604-702-2311.
3. Ask to speak with a Children & Youth with Special Needs Social Worker.
4. Once the MCFD Social Worker has made the referral (if your child/youth is eligible) - you will receive a phone call or email from us.
5. We will provide you with information about the various programs/services.
6. We will ask you to complete some documents that will provide us with information about your son/daughter.
7. Your son/daughter will begin attending programs as soon as possible.
