Fraser Valley Aboriginal Children and Family Services Society

Fraser Valley Aboriginal Children and Family Services Society (FVACFSS) provides culturally appropriate and holistic services through family strengthening, community engagement and child safety programs to Aboriginal children, youth and their families residing on and off reserve throughout the Fraser Valley.

We work in partnership with our communities to provide cultural programs, prevention, education, resources and care for Aboriginal children and youth and services for families in need.



We work together with integrity and dignity to ensure the safety and well-being of children.

FVACFSS operates with a central office located in Chilliwack and regional offices in Abbotsford, Agassiz, Langley and Mission.

FVACFSS has established programs guided under the name "Xyolhemeylh". Xyolhemeylh, a *Halq'emeylem* word, describes the special relationship between someone who requires care, and someone who provides care. It describes a relationship based on **CARING, RESPECT and LOVE.** 

### **Programs and Services**

Our services are based on the best interests of the Aboriginal child within the context of the child's family, culture, community, and his or her Kinship ties. The following is an outline of our programs and services:

- STRENGTH BASED AND SOLUTION FOCUS working in collaboration with parents and children to build solutions to ensure safety for the entire family.
- FAMILY ENHANCEMENT focusing on family growth and development as well as providing assistance in parental skills and connecting with support programs for the best needs of the family.
- COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE recognizing that family is best able to identify its strengths, challenges, resources and supports using collaborative planning. Used towards strengthening and supporting the family in caring for a child.
- FAMILY & CULTURAL CONNECTIONS building cultural plans to reconnect and develop relationships for children in care to connect with family, community and culture.
- TRADITIONAL MENTOR using traditional teachings and communication techniques to support female youth, male youth and families that receive our services.
- **► ELDER'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE** providing cultural and community based guidance to FVACFSS on difficult issues for the safety, protection and well-being of our children.

- FOSTER CARE RESOURCES recruiting, training and providing foster care homes for child(ren) who require care outside of their home.
- SHXWHA:Y FAMILY HOME families struggling with parenting and other challenges may be considered for placement in the family home as a resource of the whole family system.
- COMMUNITY CARE COMMITTEE volunteers who share their community-based input (ideas/suggestions) in regards to child welfare issues in their community.
- COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT providing preventative and remedial programs that are flexible and tailored to support and strengthen wellness in Aboriginal families and the needs of our communities.
- COMMUNITY GREETER PROGRAM greeting Aboriginal families who are new parents or new to the area and unaware of services in the community.
- AUNTS & UNCLES YOUTH MENTORSHIP knowledgeable, trained and screened volunteer mentors meet with a young person one to one, or in a group, 2-4 hours per week.
- CULTURAL SUMMER CAMPS providing an experience to many of the healthy and contemporary and traditional lifestyles of Aboriginal people, including all aspects of the medicine wheel.
