

CYC, Clinical Sub-Committee Minutes

1. Discussion re Terms of Reference (T of R):
 - a) Reviewed June 9 draft T of R document.
 - b) **Action: Work group including Kiran Sidhu, Michelle Giles, Duncan McDonald and Brenda Frisse to produce draft T of R for October 13 meeting.**
2. Connect Parenting program update: Program is currently soliciting referrals for the October Class. Duncan reports that evaluation results from initial class are generally favourable.
3. Suicide Prevention update (Michelle Giles): Michelle reported on:
 - a) World Suicide Prevention day (September 10, 2009) and an event planned for Chilliwack.
 - b) Completed summer programs
 - c) Anticipated fall programs and training opportunities.
4. ICM Training Review: Brenda Frisse, Wendy Main and Mark Littlefield are on the ICM work group. General discussion centred on the following input:
 - a) Suggestion that training occur in the fall, soon after school starts.
 - b) Suggestion for Level 1 training for new comers with little exposure to ICM; Level 2 training for folks who have some or considerable experience and training in ICM. Level 2 training would build on previous training and incorporate the latest research and best practice.
 - c) ICM training could be incorporated in community wide professional development planning.
 - d) ICM training to include community parents and families**Action: Deferred to next meeting when the work group will report.**
5. Transition of Community Living (CL) to MCFD (transition will be complete November 2, 2009). CL Chilliwack includes 300 open family service files, 2.5 fte staff. **Action: Dan Ludeman requests input into the following (to be discussed at next meeting):**
 - a) Integration of CL services with existing child and youth services in Chilliwack (ie what would an integrated service model look like, including CL services?).
 - b) How to ensure a smooth transition of services.
 - c) Issues such as location of services; key partnerships.
 - d) Integration of CL services with the CYC and with the clinical sub-committee.
