1. Reviewed Minutes of October 11 meeting. Correction to item #3 of minutes: Change “Training date is Oct 18” to “Planning date is Oct 18”.
2. **Connect Parenting** program update (Duncan): Plans are underway to convene a group in the Spring of 2012.
3. **Suicide Prevention** planning update (Duncan/Brenda): SD #33 is planning a training session and will invite community service providers to attend the training.
4. **TRY group** report (Bruce): No report for this meeting
5. **Collaborative Practice/ICM** training report (Brenda): No report for this meeting
6. **Violence and Threat Assessment Committee** (Brenda): Brenda has recommended that this committee be amalgamated into the Suicide Prevention task group. Reasons: The same people participate in both groups; increase efficiency. **Action:** No decision made.
7. **Middle Years Initiative:** CYMH is exploring options re services for Early Middle Years.
8. **Professional Learning initiatives** for the community:
 - a) Dates available for presentations were presented. The following offers were presented:
 - i. February 7, 2011: CCS programs presentation by CCS mgrs and supervisors
 - ii. April 3, 2011: CCS – SAIP Program re Sexual Abuse reporting, signs and indicators, and healthy child development re healthy sexuality.

9. **Adolescent Day Treatment Program:** Rick Brown and Liz Louwersheimer presented on the ADTP program – see program description documents attached. Additional notes:
- a) Currently operating at capacity with 10 youths ages 13 – 18 enrolled
 - b) Enrolment is minimum 4 months, maximum 10 months
 - c) Transportation is provided via contract with a contracted driver.

Questions for consideration by the Clinical Sub-Committee:

- i. Are their Chilliwack youth who are being overlooked and could benefit from the ADTP program?
- ii. Is there a benefit in having the Clinical Sub-Committee be part of the screening process for potential “students”?

Decision Made: Rick Brown will attend the second half of the Clinical Sub-Committee to discuss Chilliwack referrals and other issues related to Chilliwack and the ADTP.

10. **Meadow Rose** (Lindsay G): Lindsay provided information on a new parent support program in Chilliwack – “Meadow Rose”. The philosophy of Meadow Rose is to provide confidential, non judgmental services to parents with young children, and help with baby supplies up to 3 years. Here is the link to their website:
