For facilitators who wish to deliver the **Parent-Child Mother Goose Program** with an emphasis on First Nations cultures and traditions
Focus on- **Halq'eméylemqel and Nlaka'pamuxin**

The Aboriginal Parent-Child Mother Goose Program is a modified P-CMG program that incorporates Aboriginal language and culture into the stories, rhymes and songs. The instructors are experienced working with Aboriginal children and families and encourage acceptance and understanding in a comfortable, safe setting.

With shared words, actions, images and feelings of rhymes and stories we help build the relationship between parents and their children. Parents learn new ways to communicate and play with their children.

This training will provide facilitators with **Halq'eméylemqel and Nlaka'pamuxin** language tool kits, a priceless library of tales and legends and a facilitator's resource book. We will discuss and practice strategies for a dynamic program that works for Aboriginal families and communities.

The **Parent-Child Mother Goose Program®** has grown and become a multifaceted organization. It has a national structure, with regional offices and local programs, and is governed by a Board of Directors from across Canada.
