

RESPs - FREE \$1,200 from the BC Government For Your Child's Education

Have you heard the great news?! Open an RESP for your child at any financial institution before your child turns 7 and receive a \$1,200 grant from the BC Government when they turn 7! Receive matching grants for every \$ you put in. 20% or 40% matching depending on your income. Additionally, lower income families may qualify for a \$500 grant from the federal government and \$150/yr after that. Apply soon! Check out www.gov.bc.ca/resp for more info.
