The Fraser Valley Child Development Centre is a progressive non-profit organization with a mission to enhance the lives of children with developmental needs. We provide early intervention, school-age and specialized services that are **community-based, accessible, inclusive** and **responsive** to the needs of children at all stages of their development. The key worker/family support worker will function as a member of the multidisciplinary early intervention team to provide family support services including families whose children and youth have complex behavioral needs or FASD. The key worker/family support worker participates in family interviews, intake visits and gathers collateral information in order to evaluate the need for service and the nature of the problem(s) as it relates to the needs of the family. This position will facilitate and advocate access to supportive resources in the community and may also be involved in presenting educational opportunities for staff, families and community partners. Some evening work required.

Education requirement is a Degree in Social Work, Child and Youth Care or equivalent.
