Position Summary:

This position is a combined position for Youth Support and ISSP position.

Youth Support: Provide focused one to one support for at risk youth to enhance their development of life skills and provide crisis intervention support.

ISSP: Provide monitoring and intensive one to one support to youth on probation.

Qualifications:

Education, Training and Experience:

- Child & Youth Care Degree/Diploma or Human Services Degree in related field combined with experience working with at risk youth
- Minimum of 1 year experience working with youth

Job Skills & Abilities for Youth Support:

- Ability to support youth with developing personal management and life skills to live independently
- To provide one to one support to youth in the areas of crisis intervention, conflict resolution mediation and maintaining healthy family relationships
- Positive communication skills and the ability to work with diverse populations
- Ability to use various computer programs to complete required documentation and required reports
- Ability to conduct needs assessments, develop service plans, complete quarterly reviews and discharge reports in collaboration with the youth and the referral source.
- Ability within diverse professional teams and environments
- Driver's License and reliable transportation.

Job Skills & Abilities for ISSP:

- Ability to provide intensive support and supervision to youth on probation, court ordered, released from custody early or out on bail.
- Ability to report non-compliance to the Youth Probation Officer.
- Ability to facilitate youth engagement in school and/or employment.
- Ability to adapt and facilitate program and develop individualized plans, in collaboration with youth, probation officer and care teams, including goals and objectives related to increasing life skills and reducing criminal behavior.
- Expertise in working with high risk youth involved in the justice system.
- Excellent crisis management skills
- Excellent understanding of safety in at-risk situations
- Excellent people and communication skills
- Excellent organization skills
