#### **Position Summary:**

PCRS seeks an experienced youth addictions outreach worker for the First Response Youth Addictions Outreach Program in Chilliwack. The youth addictions outreach workers team will provide outreach services to youth struggling with addiction. This includes being a visible presence in the community seven days per week and, connecting youth to services which includes: programming, treatment centers, cultural supports, medical facilities, detox, youth addiction programs and follow up services. This position will provide naloxone training and promote ways to increase health and safety, including connecting longer term supports back into the youth's life, namely family, community, and employment.

## Academic and Job Experience Required:

Childcare diploma plus two years' experience; or BA. in a related field and one year related experience; or a combination of related work experience and education. Experience in working with youth and addiction is necessary.
