## 5. Middle and Secondary School Review: Bob Patterson

Resulting from last year's Alternate Education Review, and focusing on the goal of "Every child a graduate with a future", a middle & secondary school review was commissioned. Will respond to the questions of: What are we doing well?; What are we not?; How can we reach the kids who are dropping out?; What can we improve?; Why are we still losing kids?

Two individual - Mike McAstocker, Don Prescott – are providing an external lens to the process. They have been conducting extensive focus groups and will have a report available by the end of November (in time for decision making at budget time in March).

Early findings / possible outcomes:

- It's all about relationship (one significant person in a student's life makes the difference).
- UCFV Partnership for trades/apprenticeship programming; Beautician training.
- AD Rundle pilot website which identifying high-risk individuals, defines strategies for these students, and tracks their progress from K-12
